ACTIVITIES IN GREECE

IN 2011-2012

Greece renewed its participation in the European project Let's Take Care of the Planet Project, with 3 involved regions: Central Macedonia, Epirus and the region of Sterea Ellada; and 4 cities: Lamia, Ioannina, Thessaloniki and Legadas. 15 youth groups (about 250 youth in total) participated in the activities.

Polis NGO was still the national coordinator, with this year a collaboration with the University of Thessalonique that contributed to the facilitators participation (young people aged 18 to 20)
